Take frequent mock tests. Set yourself exam like hours.

Revision

Brush up your concepts. Heal your disadvantaged backgrounds.

Do proper time management according valuable insight you have gained so far from your preparation and analysis.

Learn how to make good use of any scribble pads given.

More mock tests

Take frequent mock tests till you are confident you don't have to refer to books or materials for a solution. Analyze each question you haven't been able to solve without help.

Reference materials

Chose your reference materials backed with information. They should amply prepare you not just for the test but in the general purpose for which you are taking the test. Which is: a PhD or a professorship.
